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## VI. Homeowner Affidavit

### VII. Fee Clarification

Item #2 – Mobile Home Units Site: WHEN item is used for sewer excavations in a new park, the permit application should include the application fee plus the number of unit sites. WHEN setting a mobile home in a park, or a mobile or modular home on private property, a permit should include the application fee, a sewer or building drain, and a water distribution pipe.

Item #3 – Fixtures, Floor Drains, Special Drains and Water Connected Appliances Include: Water Closets, Bathtub, Lavatories, Shower Stalls, Laundry Tray, Urinal, Autopsy, Sink (any description), Emergency Eye Wash, Emergency Shower, Garbage Grinder, Water Outlet Cooler, Ice Making Machine, Water Connected Still, Slop Sink, Bidet, Cuspidor, Dishwasher, Refrigerator, Water Heater, Drinking Fountain, Condensate Drain, Washing Machine, Acid Waste Drain, Embalming Table, Bed Pan Washer, Floor Drain, Grease Trap, Starch Trap, Plaster Trap, Water Softener, Water Outlet or Connection to any Make-Up Water Tank, Water Outlet or Connection to Heating System, Water Outlet or Connection to Sprinkler System (Irrigation), Water Connected Sterilizer, Water Connected Dental Chalr or Water Connection to Carbonated Beverage Dispenser.

Item #25 – Domestic Water Treatment and Filtering Equipment: A license is not required for the installation of domestic water treatment and filtering equipment that requires modification to an existing cold water distribution supply and associated water piping in buildings if a permit is secured, required inspections performed and the installation complies with the applicable code. If the enforcing agency determines a violation exists, it shall be corrected by the responsible installer. The permit application shall include the application fee, the number of water treatment devices recorded in item #25 for \$5.00 each and the appropriate water distribution pipe (system) size fee.

# IX. INSTRUCTION FOR COMPLETING APPLICATION

GENERAL: Plumbing work shall not be started until the application for permit has been filed with St. Clair Township. All installations shall be in conformance with the State Mechanical Code. No work shall be concealed until it has been inspected. When ready for inspection, please call the Township with permit number & job location.

EXPIRATION OF PERMIT: A permit remains valid as long as work is progressing and inspections are requested and conducted. A permit shall become invalid if the authorized work is suspended or abandoned for a period of six months after the time of commencing the work. A PERMIT WILL BE CANDELLED WHEN NO INSPECTIONS ARE REQUESTED AND CONDUCTED WITHIN SIX MONTHS OF THE DATE OF ISSUANCE OR THE DATE OF A PREVIOUS INSPECTION. CANCELLED PERMITS CANNOT BE REFUNDED OR REINSTATED.
